DAR may request additional information before removing any allegedly infringing material. In the event DAR removes the allegedly infringing materials, DAR will immediately notify the person responsible for posting such materials that DAR removed or disabled access to the materials. DAR may also provide the responsible person with your email address so that the person may respond to your allegations.
