

## 2017 DAR Legislative Record

**HB 58 – Solar Bill** – This bill would have nullified long-standing solar deed restrictions. DAR successfully defeated this bill on the grounds that the State was nullifying settled property rights.

**HB 190 – Coastal Zone Act** – DAR worked to pass this important piece of legislation.

**HB 187** – DAR worked to pass this legislation.

**HB 188** – DAR successfully amended this legislation and worked to pass it.

**SCR 20** – Ecological Extinction Task Force – DAR successfully amended this Resolution in order to get a seat on the Task Force.

**HB 144 – DeIDOT Acquisition of Property for Trails/Paths** – DAR successfully amended this legislation to allow communities to vote as to whether or not they want DeIDOT to acquire community open space for trails and paths.

**HB 240** – This bill would have eliminated itemized deductions including the Mortgage Interest Deduction and the property tax deduction. DAR defeated this bill, resulting in the legislative session being extended 4 days.
